

Riverton Estate – a comprehensive bird list of 160 species

This is a list of birds that have been recorded by teams of BirdLife Overberg members during three visits to Riverton Stud. Ten species were included after the applicable SABAP2 pentad statistics had been studied. This list should not be regarded as being comprehensive, but be seen as the minimum number of species that occur in the area. An astonishing diversity of 115 bird species was positively identified from the Barry House garden alone. Birders were amazed to find birds like the Western Osprey and the Tambourine Dove and many Karoo species on this Klein Karoo farm.

A HOTBED OF ENDEMISM: The exciting news from the statistical analysis of information is that at least 68 bird species that are endemic and near-endemic to southern Africa occur in our area with many of these being “Western Cape specials”. This implies that 44% of the endemic and near-endemic species that occur in southern Africa can be found in our relatively small area. At least 39 migratory species also visit our region during the summer months.
